



UPPER DUBLIN HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES CODE OF CONDUCT

General Rules - High School Code of Conduct

I understand that participation in the Upper Dublin High School activities program is a privilege. I agree to follow the guidelines for student conduct as outlined in the "Cardinal Guide" and accept the responsibilities set forth, therein. Further, I agree to become familiar with and adhere to student requirements and responsibilities as set forth by my club advisor(s). I understand that a violation of any of these rules subjects me to discipline, which may include suspension from that activity for the balance of the school year. Further, I understand that if I am removed from an activity or position as officer, recognition for my participation will not be reflected on my transcript.

Violation of Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco Rules

During the course of my participation in the Activities Program, the use, abuse, possession, and distribution of alcohol and drugs, (including steroids) whether on or off school property, is strictly prohibited. In addition, the possession or use of tobacco on school property is prohibited.

First Offense

I understand that the first violation of this Code will result in all of the following which apply:

1. dismissal for the rest of school year from *Marching Band, Link Crew, School Musical or Drama Production, Student Government Association* and recommendation for dismissal from *National Honor Society*.
2. removal from my position as an officer with respect to any activity for the rest of the school year.

I will also be required to meet with the Upper Dublin High School Student Assistance Program Counselor. I will not be eligible for future participation in the Activities Program until said meeting has taken place.

Second Offense

Upon a second violation, *in addition to all of the above listed consequences*, a mandatory Drug and Alcohol Assessment is required.

Criminal Offenses

In addition to club and school rules, I understand that I am expected to follow all state and federal laws as well. I understand that if I am criminally charged with any offense serious enough to warrant classification as a felony or misdemeanor if committed by an adult, I may be prohibited from participating in activities pending a determination that I did not commit the offense for which I was charged.
